Methodological Innovations is indexed in major abstracting and indexing databases and currently reports the following journal-level metrics: CiteScore 3.400; SCImago Journal Rank (SJR) 0.616; h5-index 20; and h5-median 41. The journal is indexed in the Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), ProQuest, PsycINFO and Scopus.

This is an exciting opportunity to shape the strategic direction of the journal and support its continued growth.

- Providing intellectual and strategic leadership for the journal, with a focus on maintaining and strengthening its quality, reputation and reach.





- Overseeing the peer review and editorial decision-making process, working closely with authors, reviewers and Sage to ensure a rigorous, timely and constructive experience.
- Encouraging submission of high-quality and methodologically innovative research from across the social sciences, including work by early career researchers.
- Working with the Editorial Board and publisher to support the journal's development, ensuring appropriate disciplinary breadth and international representation.
- Promoting the journal within relevant academic communities and helping to shape its future direction.

Applications should set out your vision for the journal over the term of editorship and demonstrate your ability to attract, develop and champion high-quality peer-reviewed content.
