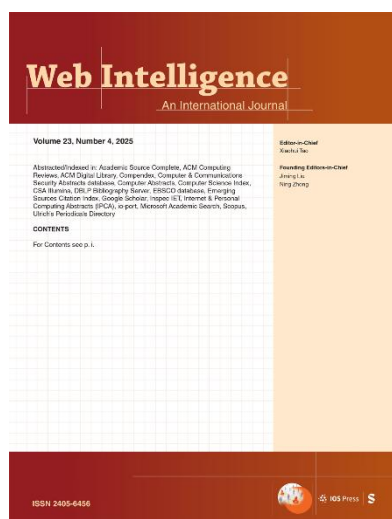


Web Intelligence: Call for Editor-in-Chief



Sage announces the search for a new Editor-in-Chief for Web Intelligence. The Editor will lead the editorial team, uphold rigorous peer-review standards and publication ethics, make final decisions on content, drive strategic development, solicit high-quality submissions, engage the editorial board, and promote the journal within the academic and professional communities. **We currently accepting Editor applications for a three-year term commencing mid-2026.**

This peer-reviewed journal which aims to achieve a multi-disciplinary balance between research advances in theories and methods usually associated with collective intelligence, data science, human-centric computing, knowledge management, and network science. It is committed to publishing research that both deepen the understanding of computational, logical, cognitive, physical, and social foundations of the future web, and enable the development and application of technologies based on web intelligence.

The journal is an official journal of the Web Intelligence Consortium, an international organization dedicated to promoting collaborative scientific research and industrial development in the era of web intelligence.

The journal has an Impact Factor of 0.3 and is indexed in Web of Science, Clarivate Analytics: Emerging Sources Citation Index (ESCI), Scopus, and EBSCO.

The Editor-in-Chief will be expected to work with Sage to ensure high-quality peer review and the timely, accurate delivery of manuscripts for publication. The incoming editor should possess extensive subject expertise, proven editorial experience, a strong academic record, and the organizational skills needed to guide the journal's continued growth and success.

Responsibilities of the Editor-in-Chief include:

- Managing selection and revision of articles through peer review in accordance with Sage policies, processes, and operational aspects, to ensure all published content is in scope and high quality.
- Upholding a high standard of publication ethics in the journal, which includes ensuring that the journal states and adheres to a rigorous peer review policy.
- Utilizing professional and academic networks to identify potential authors and invite content to the journal.
- Leading the strategic development of the journal in collaboration with the Sage publishing team, including implementing strategies for growing published content.
- Developing and engaging the editorial board.
- Representing and promoting the journal within professional and academic networks and forums.

The ideal candidate will:

- Have demonstrable experience and broad knowledge of the field of web intelligence.
- Have strong experience in writing for, reviewing for and/or working on a journal in the capacity of Editor or Editorial Board member.
- Have a good understanding of the peer review process, as well as peer review and publication ethics.
- Have a strong academic research background in a recognised university or equivalent institution.
- Be organized, responsive, proactive and driven.
- Have a broad understanding of the current trends and challenges in scholarly publishing.

Expressions of interest should be sent as a letter of application which includes an overview of the aims and vision for the Journal over the term of editorship. Applicants should also include copies of their CV and documentation indicating prospective institutional support.
